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**HMCPL, American Heart Association Partner to Offer
Blood Pressure Cuff Kits at Cavalry Hill Public Library**

New resource at Cavalry Hill Public Library

supports blood pressure monitoring and heart health awareness

Huntsville, Ala. — The Huntsville-Madison County Public Library (HMCPL), in collaboration with the American Heart Association, is now offering blood pressure cuff kits for checkout at the Cavalry Hill Public Library.

The partnership is designed to increase education and outreach in the community about heart disease, hypertension and stroke while giving patrons access to tools and information to better understand self-measured blood pressure monitoring and heart health.

Four blood pressure cuff kits will be available for checkout at Cavalry Hill Public Library. The kits may be checked out for two weeks and renewed. They must be checked out and returned at Cavalry Hill Public Library and cannot be placed on hold.

Each kit includes an A&D Medical blood pressure monitor, cuff, instruction booklet, charging cord, alcohol wipes and carrying bag.

In addition to the circulating kits, a blood pressure cuff station will be available at the branch for patrons who would like to check their blood pressure onsite.

“We are looking forward to launching this collaborative effort that will connect our community with resources empowering them to monitor their heart health,” said Connie Chow, Executive Director of the Huntsville-Madison County Public Library.

The kits are provided through support from the American Heart Association as part of the partnership’s efforts to increase awareness of hypertension prevention, healthy lifestyles and the warning signs of cardiovascular conditions.
